The Department of Modern Languages, Literatures and Cultures at Memorial University is hiring a 9-month, teaching-term appointment for the Fall 2025 and Winter 2026 semesters. The successful candidate will be a generalist in Peninsular or Latin American culture and literature but also well-versed in Spanish language instruction.

Teaching responsibilities will consist of six classes over the two terms, which include courses across the undergraduate curriculum: All levels of language, culture and civilization, film, and advanced language and culture studies.

Applicants should highlight any teaching and research expertise that aligns with these areas, or other relevant educational and professional experiences that make them well-suited to teaching these types of courses. Candidates must have a native or near-native fluency in Spanish, as well as a strong command of oral and written English.

In most cases, the successful candidate will have a completed PhD in Spanish or have status as a Doctoral Candidate (i.e., "ABD").

## Applicants must submit:

- 1. a curriculum vitae
- 2. letter of interest outlining relevant teaching and/or research experience
- 3. statement of teaching philosophy
- 4. a dossier that includes samples of course syllabi and summary of teaching evaluations
- 5. the names and contact information of three referees
